However, students are free to paint whatever subject inspires them at the designated painting sites. Weather permitting we'll be outdoors, in case of rain we'll paint from fresh flowers indoors. If you have never taken a painting workshop before, this is an easy way to get started!

Pat Fiorello, professional artist and instructor known for her vibrant watercolors of florals, gardens and landscapes, is returning to Callaway to lead this workshop. Workshop will include demonstrations, painting time and critiques. Topics to be covered will include how to paint flowers in a way that gives them form and dimension, how to mix natural looking greens (always a challenge for painters) and how to achieve depth in your paintings.
